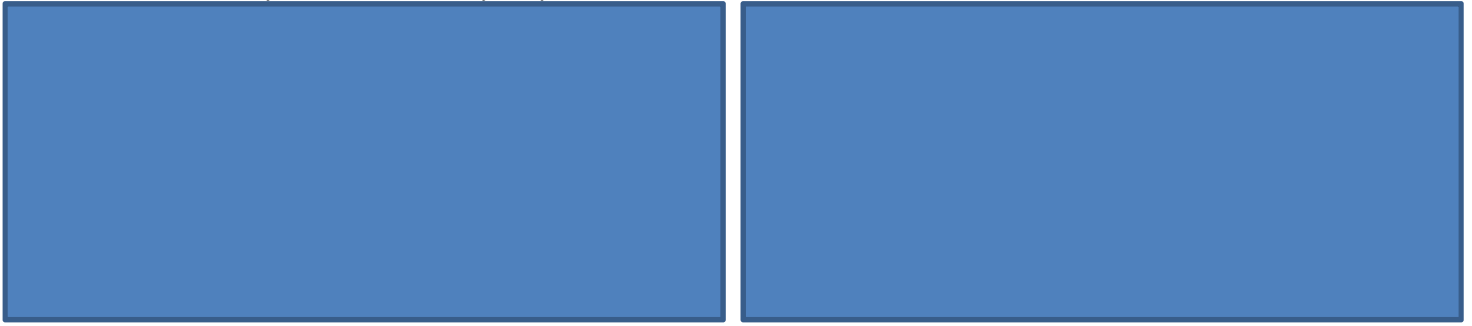


Start with 5 yards navy blue 100% polyester. Make sure you get the 60" wide. Also make sure it is the kind that does not ravel. Cut in half. Now you have two 2 ½ yard pieces.

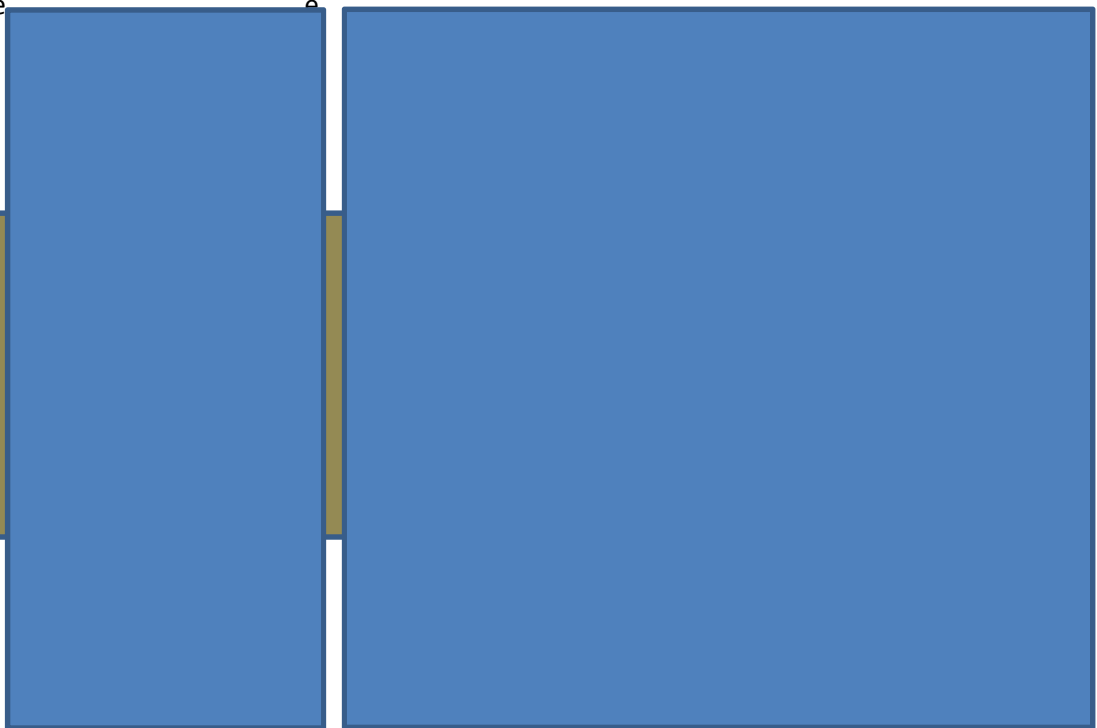


Turn the piece long wise and place over your 8' table. Open up, pin in the center using safety pins.

8' table



This will cover your table front to back, touching the floor on both sides.



Cut edge



Move to the end of the table and draw up the excess, front to back. Line up the edge so the bottom still touches the floor. Sort of crossing over like a gift wrap. Pin again using safety pins. Draw up the other side back to front and pin. Do the same with the other end. Try to keep the pins hidden as much as possible. The use of straight pins creates a safety hazard so please avoid using them.

You can also make a fitted table cover, or have one made for you. The guild also has plain fitted table covers that can be purchased for \$35.00. Keep your covers clean and neat by laundering between shows. You may also use table runners or accent pieces on your table top but they cannot hang over the edges more than six inches.
