

This application is for artists and crafters who are not Members of The Toledo Craftsman's Guild.

If you are a current Member of The Guild, contact one of the show chairs or see the Guild's Website for the appropriate application.

The Toledo Craftsman's Guild invites you to participate in the 2023 Spring Crafters' Showcase at Tam-O-Shanter Sports and Exhibition Hall.

WHEN: Saturday, April 1, 2023, 10am-4pm

SET UP TIMES: Friday, March 31, 2023, 6:30pm-9:00pm and Saturday, April 1, 2023, 7am-9:30am

WHERE: Tam-O-Shanter Sports and Exhibition Center, 7060 Sylvania Ave., Sylvania, OH 43560

DEADLINE: March 14, 2023, however, **applications will be taken until the show is full.** A wait list will be created for last minute substitutions. Applications are processed in the order in which they are received.

FEES

NON-REFUNDABLE JURY FEE: \$20 for first 3 craft categories, \$20 for each additional category

BOOTH FEE: \$70 per 10ft wide x 10ft deep space(center corner spaces). \$80 for 10ft deep x 12ft wide space (wall spaces).

TABLE RENTAL: \$10.50 each

ELECTRIC: \$20 per space. Bring heavy duty (14 gauge) extension cords and tape (not duct tape) to securely fasten your cords to the floor.

TABLECOVERS: We have a limited number of navy blue table covers available for rent. These are first come, first serve.

DISPLAY

SPACES: You will be responsible for making sure your preferred display setup fits into the space dimensions. Fire code regulations prohibit extending beyond your assigned space(s) and into the aisles.

TABLES: All tables and work stations, no matter what size or shape, must be covered to the floor on all sides unless the table is decorative in nature (i.e., wooden claw foot table). Table covers must be clean and pressed. Board Members of The Toledo Craftsman's Guild will be circulating before the show and will ask you to correct any table coverings that do not meet these required standards.

EVENT

SECURITY: There will be onsite security inside and outside the show.

AFTER THE SHOW: Please double check and clean up your space before leaving.

BALLOON SPECIAL: We will be having our Balloon Special again this year. This is the only Guild show that allows participants to sell their products at a discount or to have a sale. If participating, crafters will receive a balloon for their booth so customers know you have sale options. If you are interested in participating, mark the box on your application.

GUEST CRAFTER PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS: Failure to follow these rules may result in not being invited to participate in future shows.

- 1) Work that is submitted for jurying must be the original creation of the artist/craftsperson, must not be produced by employees, and be at least 70% hand crafted. No item may be mass-produced on a duplicating or copy machine. Original art work may be professionally copied, but the items displayed may not comprise more than 20% of the booth display.
- 2) Items not accepted: commercial kits; plastic flower, fruits, or greenery; plastic needlepoint; quickie decoupage, mod podge, or poured finish; jewelry composed entirely of commercial findings and/or pre-cut stones; assembled items that are not 70% handcrafted; pom-pom, beaded items, and bazaar items; other items at the Jurying Committee's discretion
- 3) Participants must be set up 30 minutes prior to the show's starting time and remain set up until closing time. Packing and teardown will not begin until the show is officially over.
- 4) Food items may not be prepared at the show.
- 5) No use of radios or TV is allowed. Electronic devices may be used to show a participant's creative process or uses of art.
- 6) All state and local smoking ordinances will be obeyed. Smoking, including electronic cigarettes, is permitted only in designated areas.
- 7) No sale signs implying a price reduction are permitted. Signs such as "Seasonal" or "Discontinued" may be used as long as it says nothing about a price reduction. For this show only, signs such as "Ask me about my Balloon Special" are permitted.
- 8) Items necessary for sale of a craft (such as suction cups or belt buckles or necklace chains) may not be priced and sold separately.
- 9) No re-sale items (buy/sell) are permitted. Artists and Crafters who are found to be selling buy/sell items will be asked to remove them. Artists/Crafters who fail to remove the items will be asked to leave the show and will not be allowed to participate in future shows.
- 10) Use of aerosol sprays, epoxy glues, etc., may only be used outdoors due to their strong odors and to protect floor surfaces.
- 11) Courteous behavior is expected of all show participants. Profanity (verbal or nonverbal) is not permitted.
- 12) Pets are not permitted at set up, tear down, or during shows. Properly documented service animals are permitted.
- 13) Proper attire and footwear are required.

JURY PROCESS: Your art/craft must meet the standards set by the Jurying Committee. Each member of the Jurying Committee will evaluate your work for: Originality (1-5 points), Quality (1-10 points), and Appearance (1-5 points). The individual scores of the Jurying Committee will be averaged for a total score. You must receive a total score of at least 14 points to be considered for the show. Once all applicants are juried, the scores will be ranked in descending order. Applicants with the highest scores will be invited by email to participate in the show until spaces are filled. Applicants who are not invited will be placed on a waitlist.

You will be notified by email within two weeks of the receipt of your application. You will be notified a second time when your items have been juried and whether you are invited to participate or not. If you do not have an email address, you may provide a self-addressed and stamped postcard or envelope which will be mailed to you.

Location maps will be emailed one week prior to the show. If you do not have an email address, you may provide a self-addressed and stamped envelope for a mailed copy of the show map.

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COVID-19 RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1) We will be following the current COVID guidelines for the day of the show. .
- 2) Use an EZ-Up-type canopy with walls or a curtained wall (pipe-and-drape) to separate your booth from your neighbor's is acceptable. Please mark your application if you intend to use a canopy or walls in your space.

INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING WITH YOUR COMPLETED APPLICATION:

- A \$20 check for the first 3 categories in which you wish to be juried. Add \$20 to your check for each additional category you wish to be juried in.
- A sperate check for the booth spaces you wish to purchase (include the cost of table rental/electric on a per space basis)
- A minimum of 3-5 close-up photos of items that best represent each category selected (i.e., if you are being juried in 2 categories, you will include 6-10 photos)
- 2 photos of you making your product (face and hands in photo)
- A photo of your booth display
- A short essay of how you create your product from start to finish
- A list of shows you have participated in during the previous 12 months. Not having a list of previous shows does not mean you will automatically be rejected from the show. We understand some artists may be just starting their art show career.
- Food vendors only: a copy of your Department of Agriculture certification either as a licensed Bakery or a Cottage Food Industry
- A self-addressed and stamped envelope for show information once the show map is complete (optional)

Confirmation that your application and information were received will be emailed to the email address you provide on your application.

No refunds will be given if you are accepted into the show unless we can fill your space from a waitlist.

If for some reason you are unable to attend the show after you have been accepted, please contact one of the following Co-Chairs.

The Guild's Constitution and Bylaws require show participants to notify the Chairpersons **prior to the show** if you cannot attend.
